2018	(date code J)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2018)</i>
2019	(date code K)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2019)</i>
2020	(date code L)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2020)</i>
2021	(date code M)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2021)</i>
2022	(date code N)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2022)</i>
2023	(date code P)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2023)</i>
2024	(date code Q)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2024)</i>
2025	(date code R)	7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2025)</i>

The two digits following the year code indicate the week number in which the product was assembled. You can find this information on a small white sticker on the back of the product or on one of the springs.

The warranty period starts from the invoice date of the relevant delivery.
