| 2023 | (date code P) | 7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2023)</i> |
| 2024 | (date code Q) | 7 years on the entire programme <i>(valid from 01-01-2024)</i> |

The two digits following the year code indicate the week number in which the product was assembled. You can find this information on a small white sticker on the back of the product or on one of the springs.

The warranty period starts from the invoice date of the relevant delivery.
